

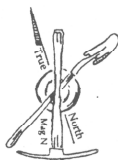

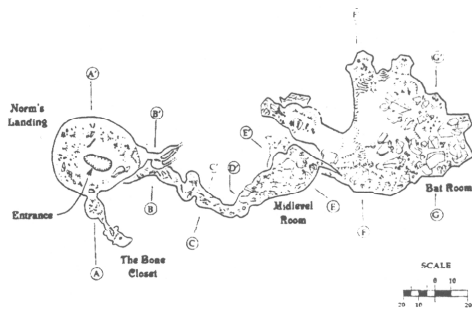

## Plan View of Entire Cave

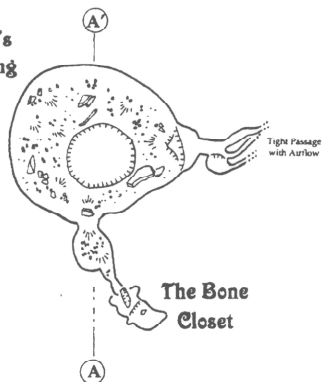

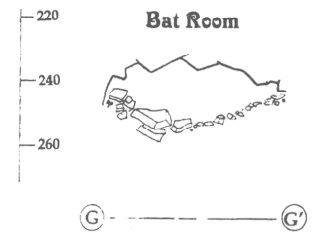
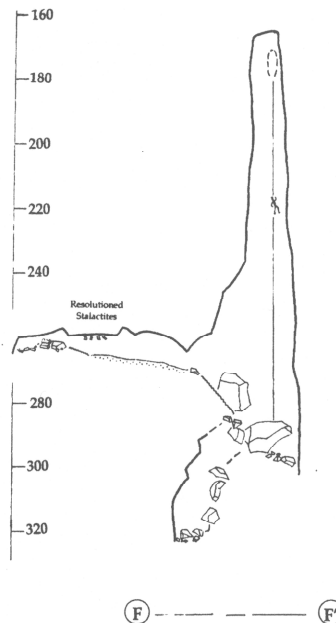
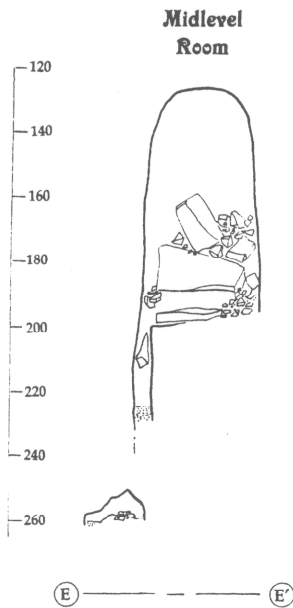
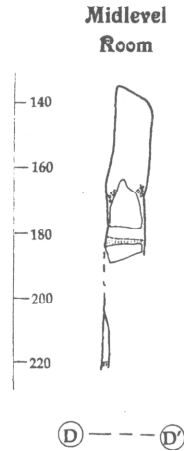
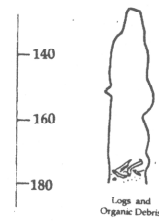
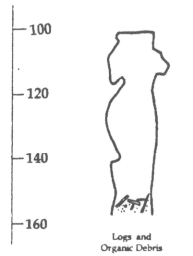
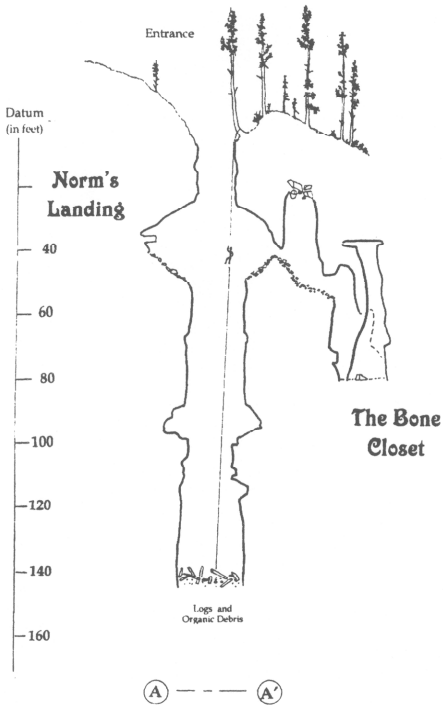
## Cross-Sections
